

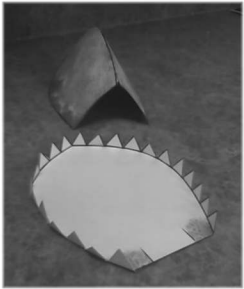

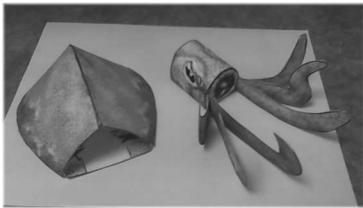

Instructions

Squid



1. Glue tabs along top of mantle sections. Fold up tabs of base and glue mantle into place making a tent shape with the front open.

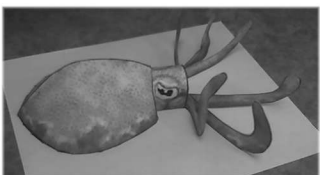


2. Fold and glue each tentacle, then group tentacles into threes, glue fat ends together and fan them out.

Fold over head arch, sliding tentacle group into either side of head and glue into place.



3. Slide head section into open end of mantle and glue along bottom edge.



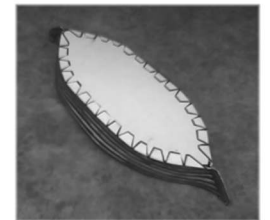
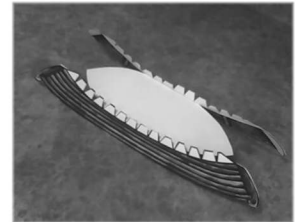
Jollyboat

1. Fold up side gunwhales of hull section.

Line up and glue outside gunwhales in place.

2. Fold tabs under hull.

Glue bow and stern sections together, and then glue tabs under the hull.



3. Fold and glue mast together into a three sided tube, folding out the base tabs of the mast.

Curve mast rings and glue white tabs into a keyhole shape.



4. Fold over the front/back sections of the sail. Cut a one cm notch at both the bottom and top edges of the fold.

Slide the mast rings into the notches before glueing the sail front to back.

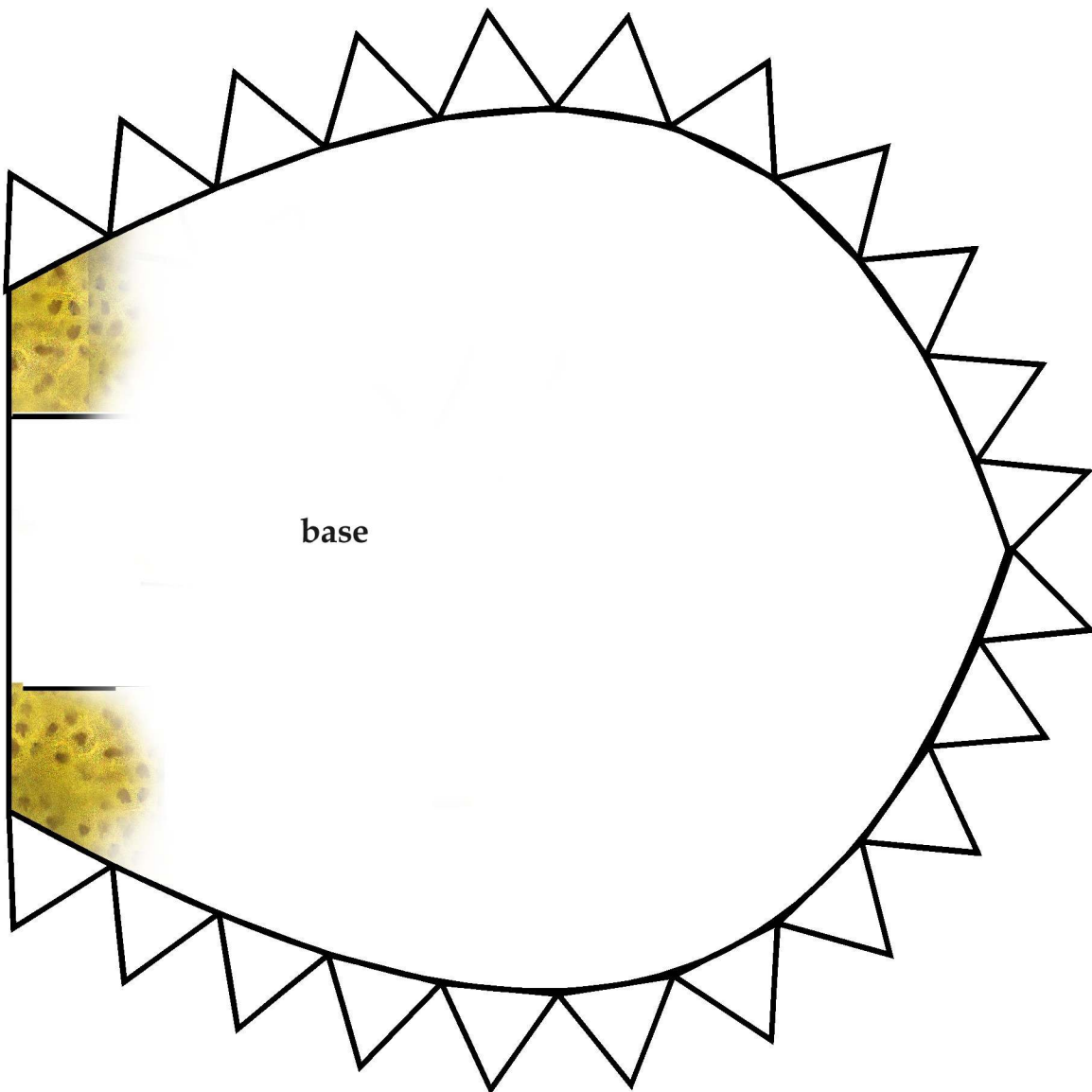
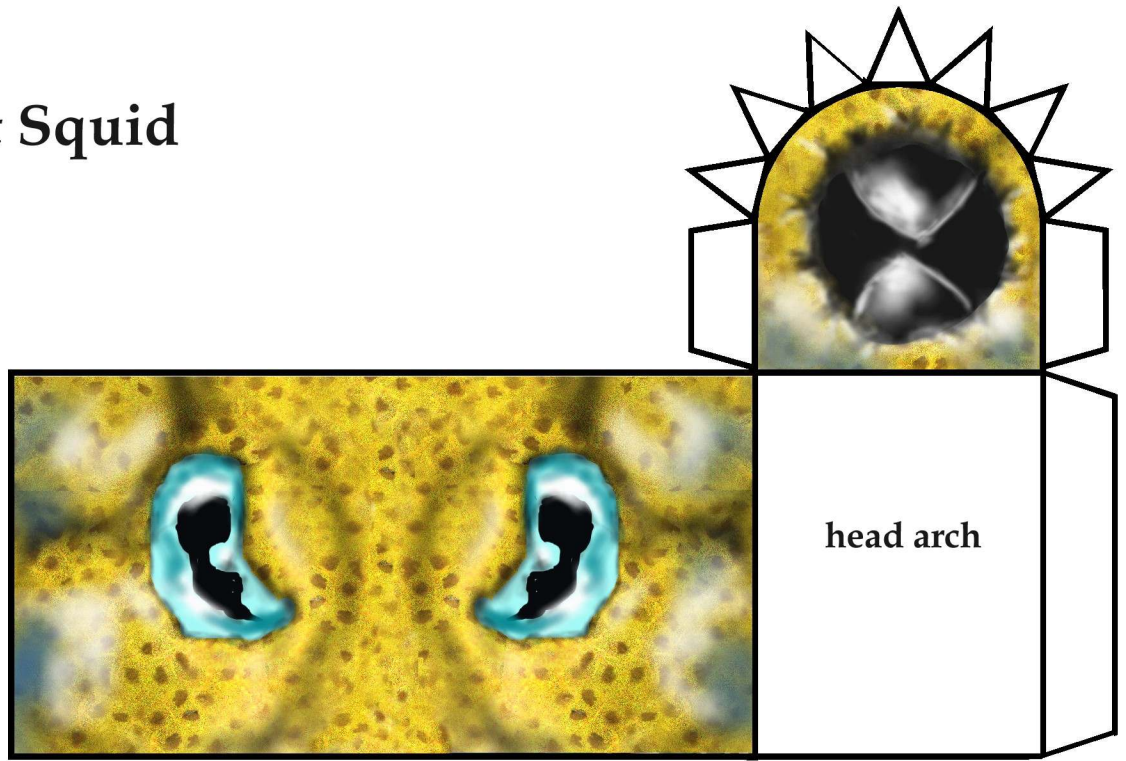


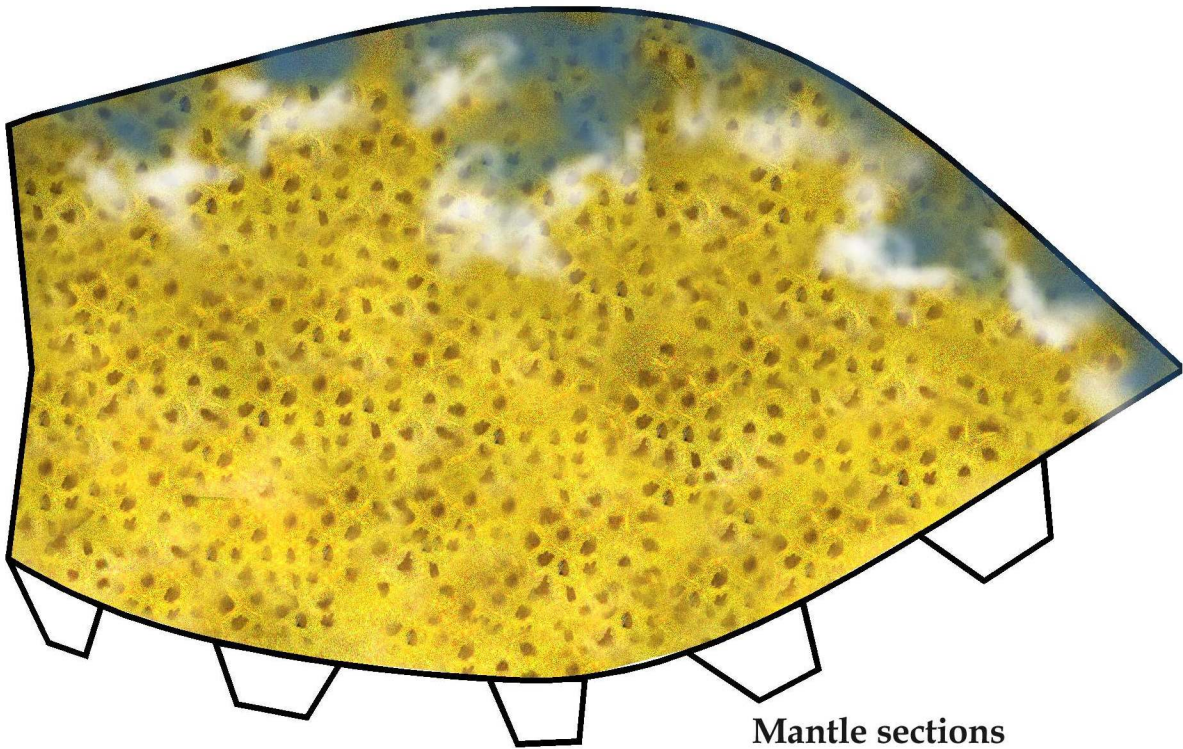
5. Glue the mast near the front of the hull.

Slide the sail over the mast (don't glue, the tabs should hold it in place). Fold and glue the tiller in place over the stern.



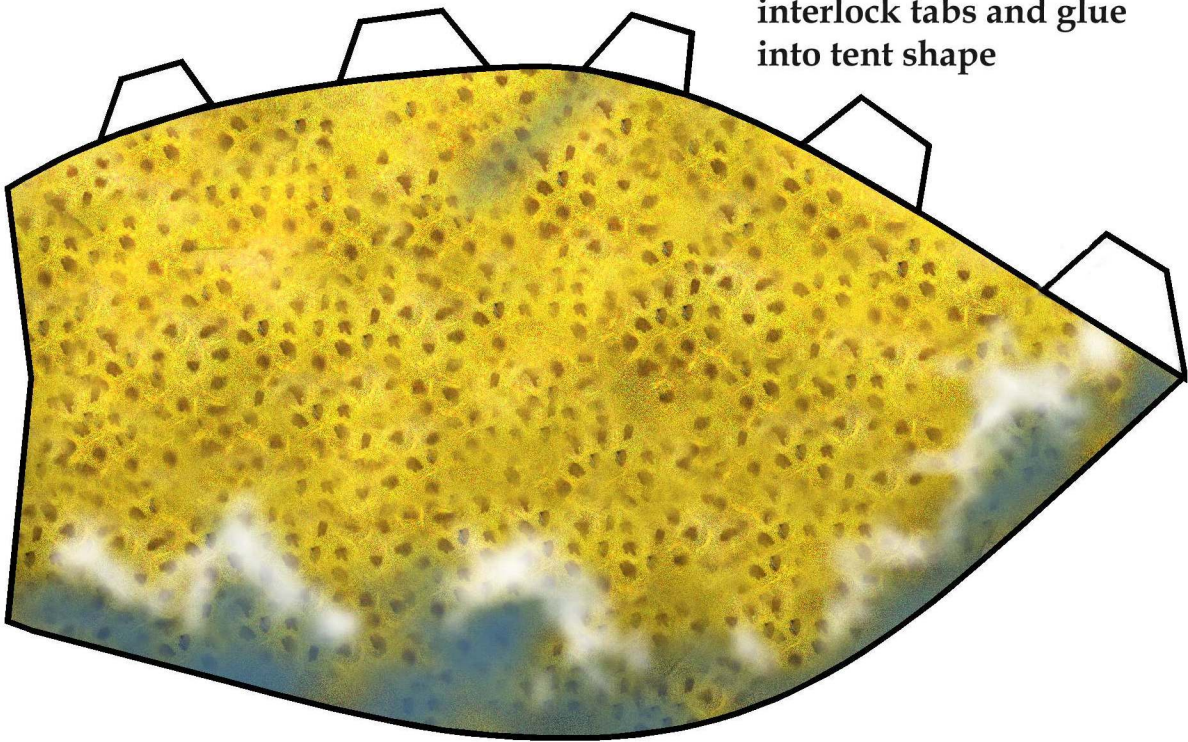

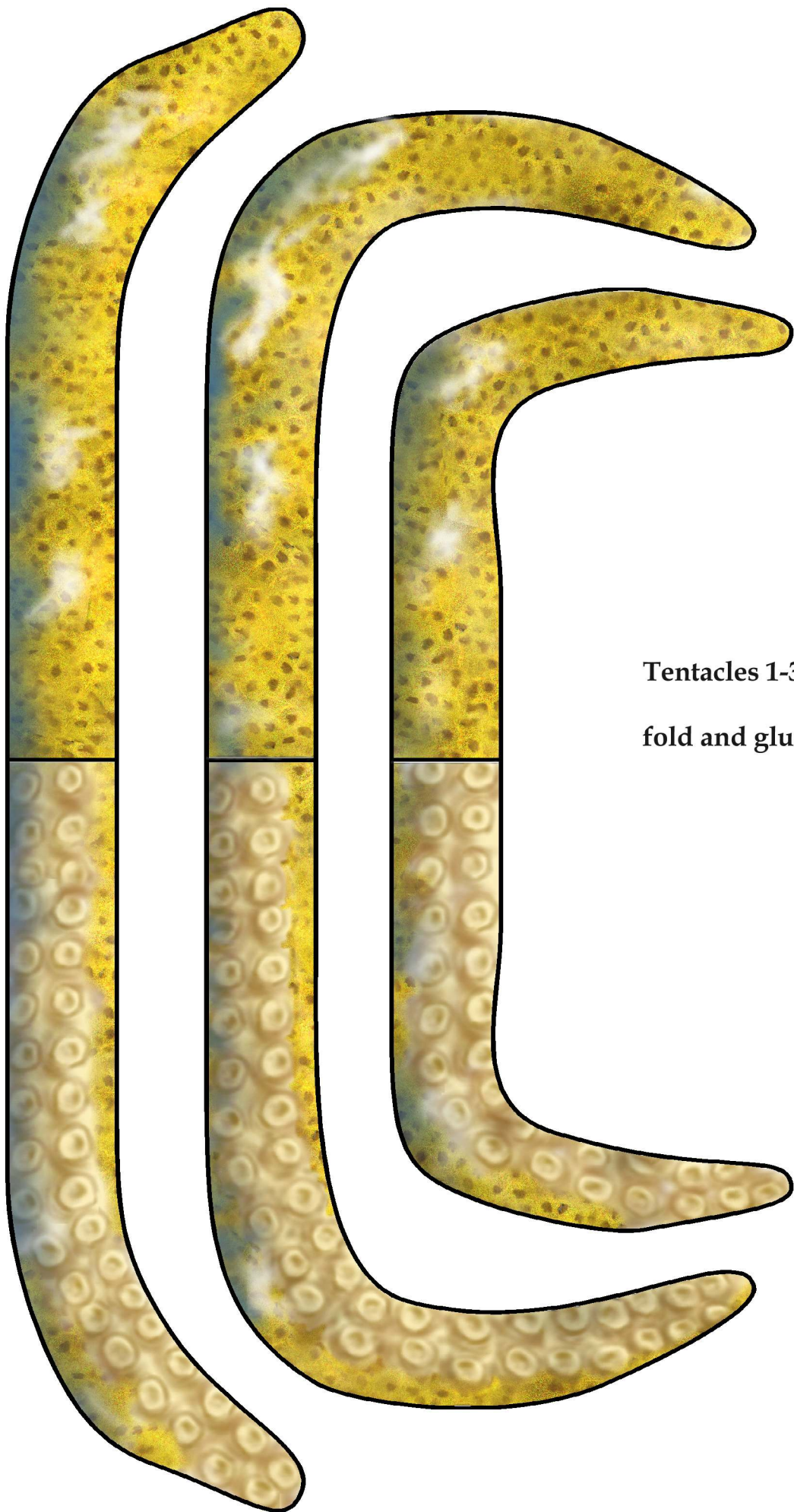




Mantle sections

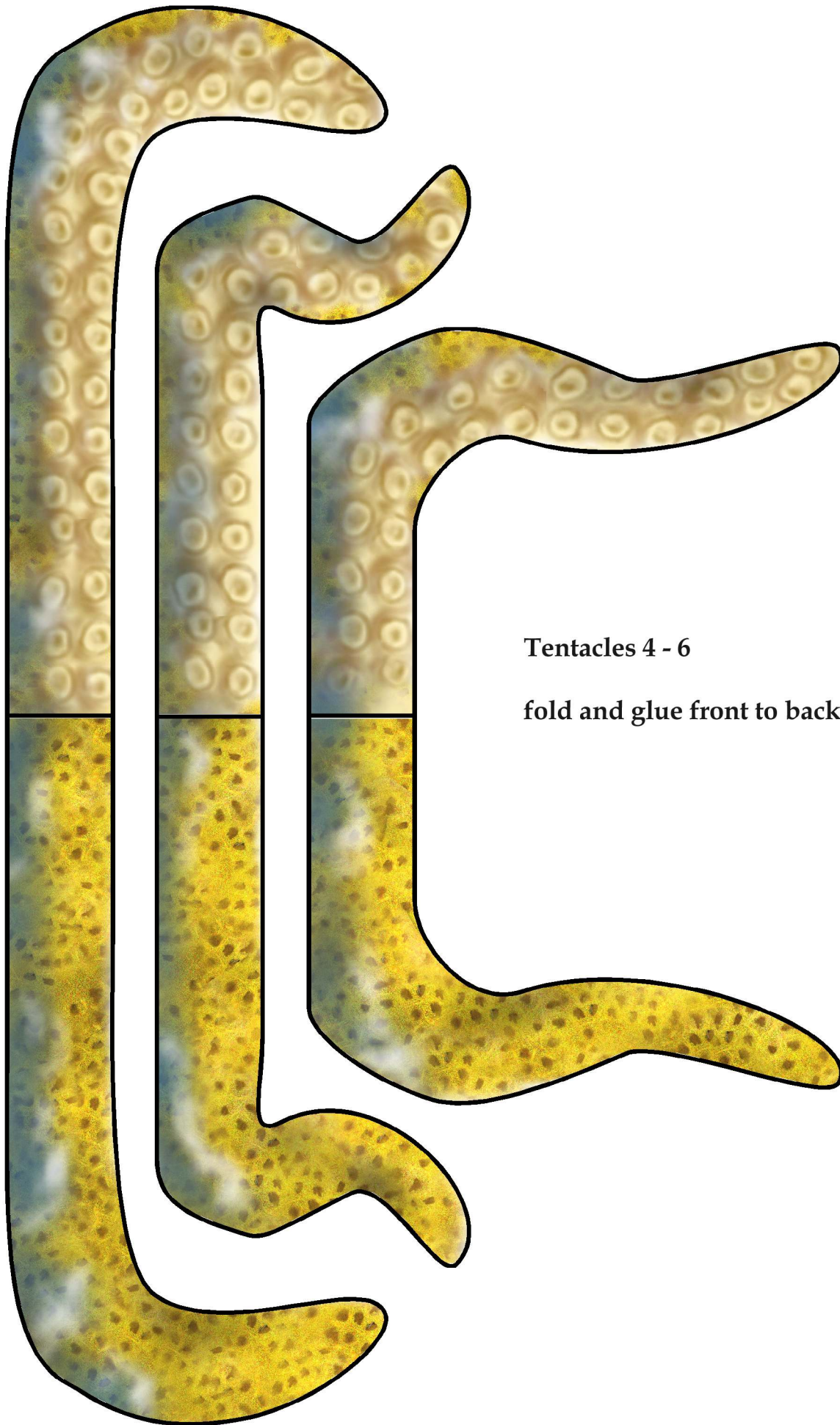
interlock tabs and glue

Tentacles 1-3

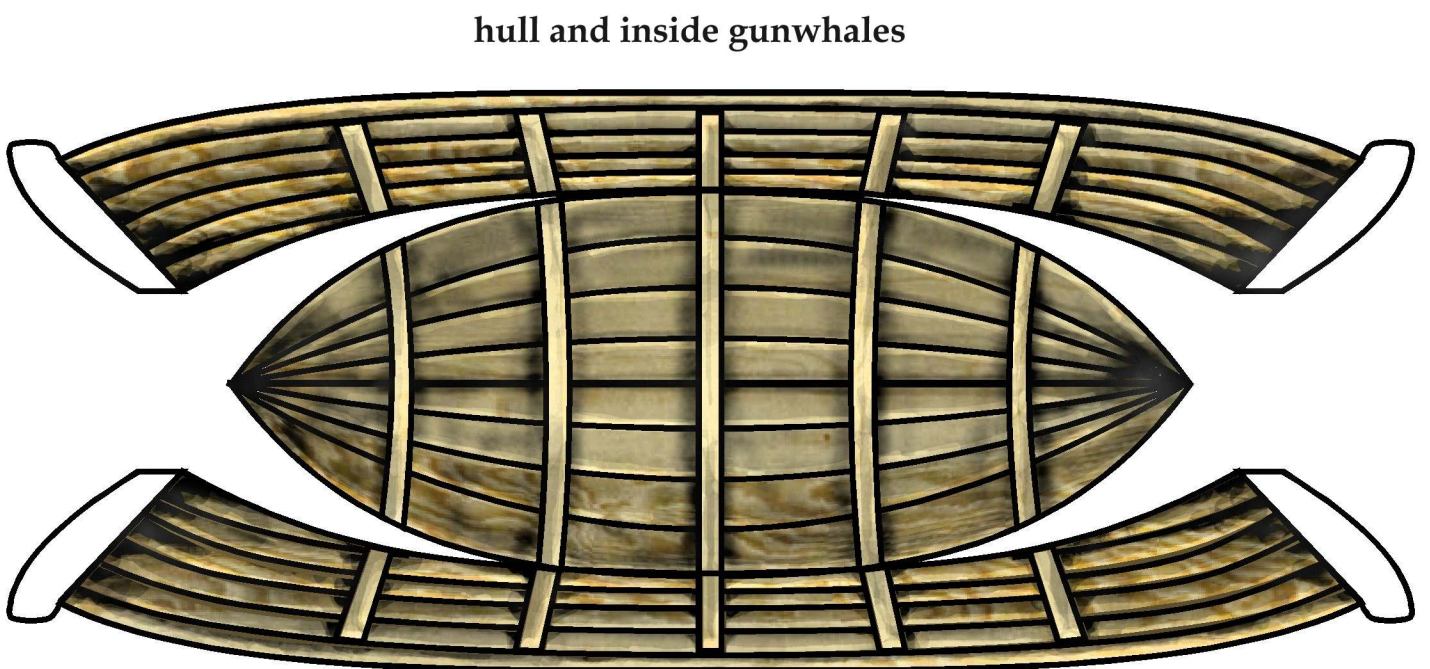
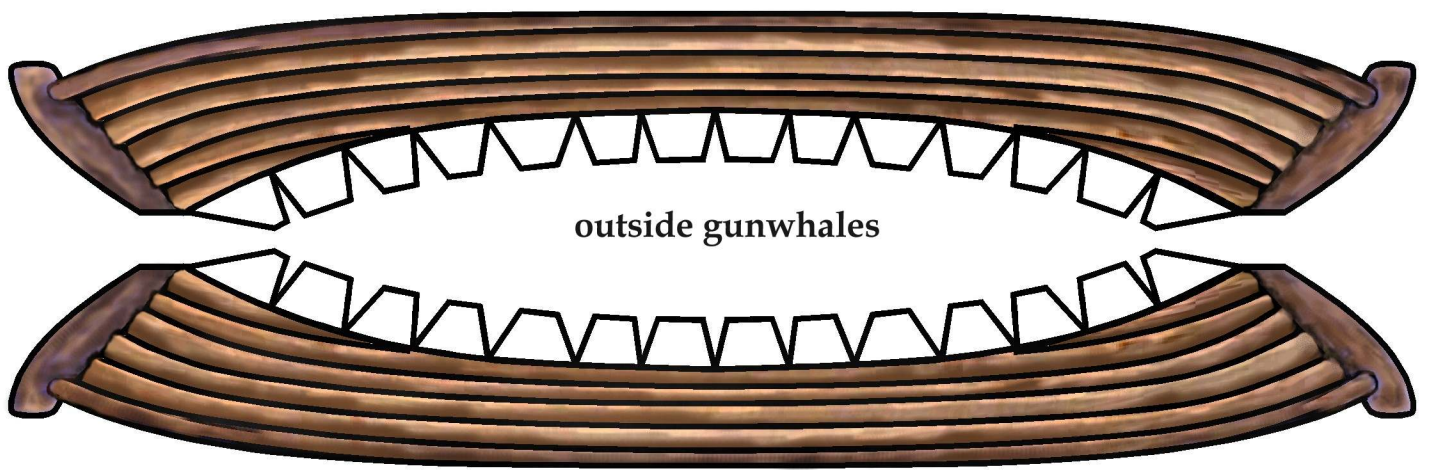
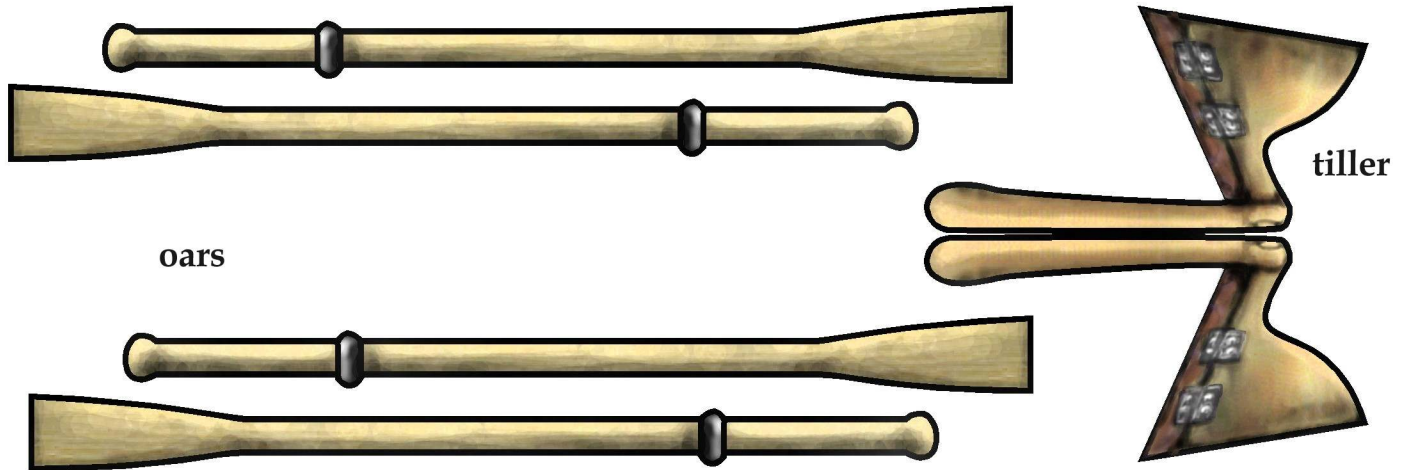
fold and glue front to back

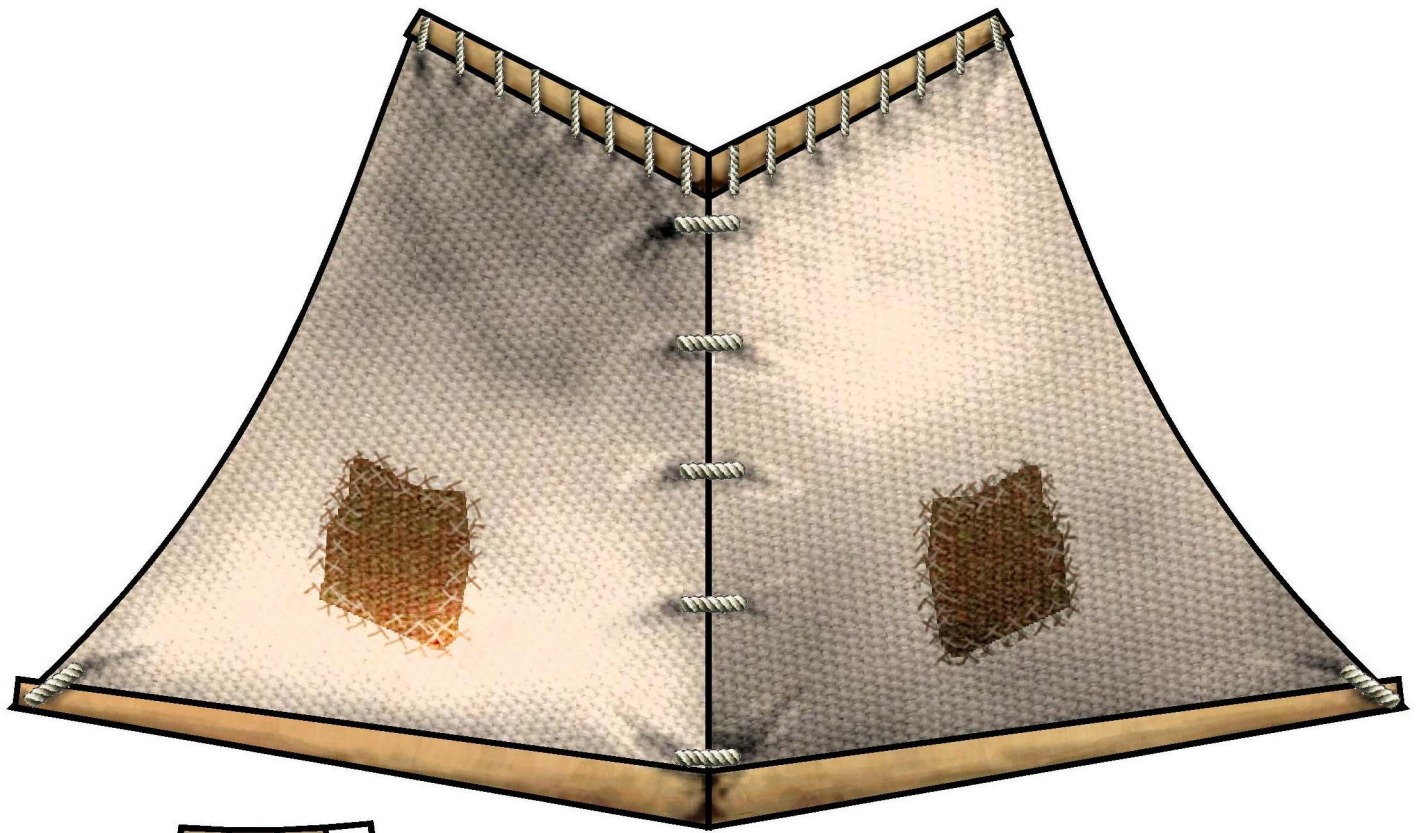


Tentacles 4 - 6

fold and glue front to back

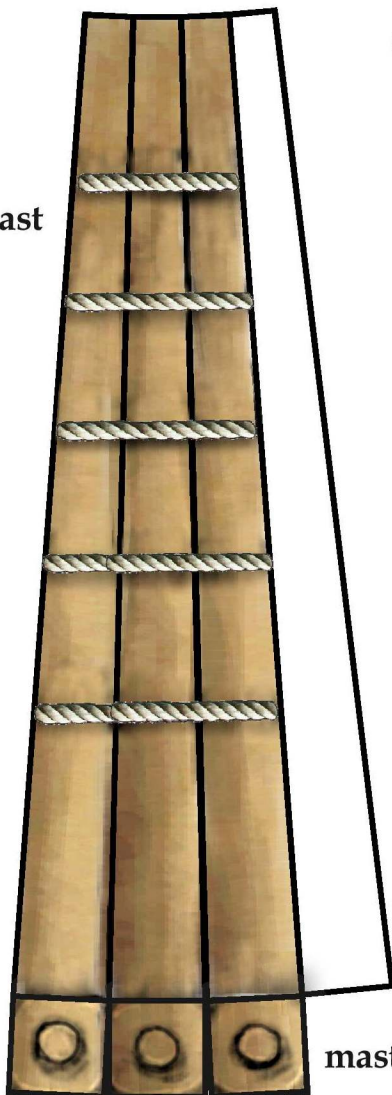

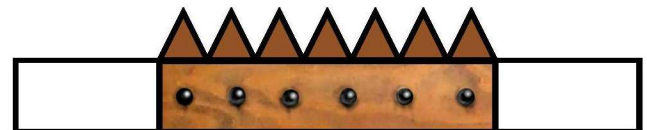


sail front/back (fold and glue with mast rings in place)
